



Workshop Fitter – Tool Hire

The Role

The Tool Fitter is responsible for preparing equipment ready for hire, to include service and maintenance procedures, and to complete off hire inspections following the return of equipment.

Utilise the system to track all labour worked and stock parts used on assets.

Key Responsibilities:

Service and Maintenance

Complete service and maintenance works on air, fuel and electrical tools. Utilise system workflow for all tasks to include labour worked and parts used. Feedback to team leader on stock requirements.

Liaise with the team leader on the progress of ongoing jobs, and update on completion times.

Equipment Returns

Assist with the management of the quarantine area, to ensure equipment returned from site is checked over efficiently to highlight potential damage at the earliest opportunity.

Complete full inspections for all off hired equipment and document repair work using the correct function within the system, stating labour worked and parts used.

Process

Adhering to company policies, safety regulations and risk assessments.

Service and maintain all equipment in line with manufacturers guidelines/specifications.

Contribute to near miss procedure and close out where possible.

Quality

Maintain excellent levels of house keeping for your area, ensure it is free from waste.

Record and maintain weekly checks on equipment used.

Fully accountable for the quality of work.

Recommending improvements to processes to assist with continuous improvement.

Efficiency

Working effectively within the team to include excellent time keeping and adjusting to department demands as dictated by production schedules and workflow
