## Clean Water Valve Technician

### The Role:

Valve Technician will be responsible for operating sluice valves on Severn Trent's clean water system ensuring properties are notified correctly, flushing mains, and taking water samples. Ensuring new mains are chlorinated to specifications. The role also involves checking that valves are operational and ensuring all operations are carried out under an in date R & C document. This role will suit candidates who have experience and knowledge in operating clean water systems and understanding of R & C documents.

### Key Responsibilities:

#### Procedures and Checks

Carry out shut offs on the water systems correctly using due diligence.

Flushing water mains to correct procedures

Carrying out valve checks in advance of works being carried out and valves are operational.

Ensuring correct amount of water samples are taken at the right time and delivered to the Severn Trent Water drop off points within time specified and turbidity is monitored

#### Deliver to Timelines

Notifying customers to the correct timeline and ensuring shut offs do not over run

#### Administration

Ensuring R & C Documents are in date and are correct for the works being carried out.

Correct water samples are taken and chlorination and procedures are followed
