The Role:

Within one of our frameworks we have the requirement for an Environmental Advisor. The role involves supporting the framework manager to ensure consents are applied for and in place prior to works taking place. To ensure Environmental policies and standards are in place and adhered to. Assisting the team through on site briefings to recognise hazards, minimize risk and improving the environmental standards in the workplace. The post-holder will act as the regional champion and will provide support to the existing HSEQ advisors where necessary.
