- Provide regular updates on progress (time, cost, and quality) to the Construction Manager and other key internal stakeholders
- Responsible for delivery of projects in line with tender allowances and agreed programmes of work, actively managing any slippage
- Proactively support planning responsibilities to ensure initiatives are implemented with minimal disruption, these include resourcing, project requirements and estimations
- Procurement of plant, materials and specialist subcontractors using an appropriate financial management accounting system to ensure projects are delivered within tender allowances
